SERVICES INCLUDED:

Emotional support, safety planning, hotline calls, individual advocacy services, Lethality Assessment Protocol response, victim's rights and criminal justice information, protection order information, emergency medical advocacy, housing assistance, education assistance, parenting education/skills, individual therapy, telehealth, and support groups.

THERAPY SESSIONS

Sessions of individual therapy provided to 4 clients in Emerado, will provide therapy at area schools in 2024 to help families overcome transportation/financial barriers.

Connecting with Emerado public schools

At the beginning of the school year, staff met with the school principal to discuss prevention and intervention services and provided resources.

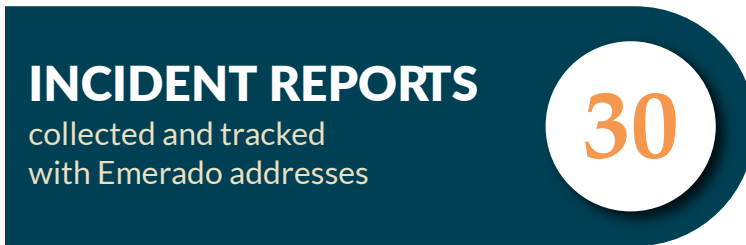
PROMOTING A SAFER COMMUNITY

Notification of Criminal Justice Events, Criminal Justice Advocacy/Court Accompaniment, Info on Victims' Rights & Notification, Info on the Criminal Justice System, Prosecution Interview Advocacy/Accompaniment, Individual Advocacy, Restitution Assistance, Crisis Intervention, Financial Assistance/Advocacy

CRIMES INCLUDED:
Adult Physical Assault, Adult Sexual Assault, Burglary, Child Physical Abuse or Neglect, Criminal Mischief, Disorderly Conduct, Domestic and/or Family Violence, Identify Theft/Fraud, Interference or Wire or Oral Communication, Theft of Property



GRANT SUCCESS:
We reapplied for and were granted OVW Rural funding for 2024-2027 with the support of Chief Lund to provide services in Emerado.

- 13 suspects were arrested
- 5 were ordered to participate in DV Court
- 10 lethality screens were conducted
