served through advocacy and therapy **110** different times throughout the year.

#### SERVICES INCLUDED:

Emotional support, crisis intervention, safety planning, housing assistance, education assistance, parenting education/skills, hotline calls, individual advocacy services, Lethality Assessment Protocol response, Child Advocacy Center response, Law Enforcement interview accompaniment, court accompaniment, protection order information, victim's rights and criminal justice information, group & individual therapy, and telehealth.

### THERAPY SESSIONS

Sessions of individual therapy provided to **3** clients in Larimore, will provide therapy at area schools in 2024 to help families overcome transportation/financial barriers.

**TRENDING UP:** The youth therapist and rural advocate positions experienced turnover in 2023 with a significant gap before the positions were filled. New data for first half of 2024 shows an increase in clients reached in Larimore.

### SERVICES PROVIDED:

Notification of Criminal Justice Events, Criminal Justice Advocacy/Court Accompaniment, Info on Victims' Rights & Notification, Info on the Criminal Justice System, Prosecution Interview Advocacy/ Accompaniment, Individual Advocacy, Victim Impact Statement Assistance, Restitution Assistance, Financial Assistance/Advocacy, Crisis Intervention

### GRANT SUCCESS:

We reapplied for and were granted OVW Rural funding for 2024-2027 with the support of the Sheriff's Office to provide services in Larimore.

- 5 suspects were arrested
- 2 ordered to participate in DV Court
- 3 lethality screens were conducted
