## CVIC Adopt a Family 2025 FAQ



- Q: What is Adopt-A-Family?
- A: The Adopt a Family (AAF) project is designed to provide holiday assistance to single adults and families whose lives have been impacted by interpersonal violence.
- Q: How are clients chosen?
- A: Victim service programs will compile a list of clients that are currently/actively receiving services and that have a need for holiday assistance.
- Q: Can I choose the client/family I get to donate to?
- A: If you have a particular family size that you would like to donate to, please let us know! Specific client information is not provided due to confidentiality.
- Q: How much should I give?
- A: There is no set amount of money the supporter needs to give.
- Q: What should I buy?
- A: We ask that supporters give gift cards (no cash gifts, please) so the client or parent/guardian of the client can purchase gifts they know they/their children will love. *Please consider also supplying gift wrap, ribbons and tape!*
- Q: Does my donation get distributed across families?
- A: No, whatever you donate to your family will go to that family. If one client's support falls through or receives a small amount compared to their family size, we will supplement as we are able to with other toys from our donation room or donated gift cards.
- Q: How do I get my items to the client?
- A: Gifts may be brought to CVIC, and staff will distribute to the client/family. Drop off events featuring light refreshments will take place:
  - Wednesday, Dec. 10 | 5:30-7 p.m.
  - Thursday, Dec. 11 | 5:30-7 p.m.
  - Friday, Dec. 12 | 5:30-7 p.m.
  - $\circ~$  Saturday, Dec. 13 | 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Q: Can I bring my gift cards/donations during regular CVIC business hours?
- A: We want to be flexible with your schedule; however, we ask for all AAF contributions to
  be brought during the outlined drop off schedule if at all possible. This is to minimize the
  disruption of clients seeking services during CVIC business hours. Please call to schedule
  an alternative drop off time if you are unable to make it to the scheduled drop off events.
